

## QSO-TV HELP FILE

-----

Qso-TV is a free add-on to the CQ100 transceiver. It is designed to allow sharing of JPG photographs during a QSO. The latest version of Qso-TV can be downloaded at <http://qsonet.com>

Once the program has been installed, you will see the QTV icon on your desktop, and QsoTV will appear in your Windows Start menu.

### HOW TO OPEN QSO-TV

In order to use QsoTV,

- 1) Your CQ100 must be already running (version 2.0 or higher).
- 2) You must have a paid-up membership to the QsoNet virtual ionosphere.

Double click the desktop icon, or use the Windows Start menu. Your firewall may request permission for QsoTV.exe to use the internet.

### HOW TO SEND A PICTURE

You can drag and drop a picture file onto the TV, or use the FIND button. Your transceiver does not need to be keyed up (ON THE AIR) in order to transmit a picture. Files must be .JPEG or .JPG format. Your outgoing picture is automatically resized to fit the QsoTV screen size and your callsign will be engraved near the lower right corner.

Once you have loaded the desired picture onto your TV, click the XMIT button to send it out.

All of the listeners (including lurkers) on your frequency are able to see your picture.

### HOW TO RECEIVE PICTURES

A picture will be automatically received when anyone on the frequency decides to send one. Use the provided forward / backward buttons to browse through the most recent 30 pictures.

There is a setting under "CONFIG" to automatically save all received pictures onto your hard drive.
